Who we are...

- We are the only **kindergarten through 12th grade** classical school in the St. Louis area.
- **Multi-Denominational Christian.** We teach the beliefs we have in common —the *Solas* of the Reformation. We employ staff from many denominations including: Lutheran, Presbyterian, Anglican, Baptist, Evangelical Free, Non-denominational, and others. We are not affiliated with a church.
- **Co-Educational**
- **College Preparatory**
- **Extracurricular activities:** scouting, chess, volleyball, basketball, cross country/track, drama, choir, and more.

How will classical Christian education help YOUR student?

LANGUAGE: We teach Latin for six years and Greek for two years. Students master the English language, think critically, and achieve test scores that are among the best in Missouri (our students' *average* test scores are in the **top 10%** of all students nationwide).

WRITING: Every grade uses the Progymnasmata, a composition curriculum used in the West for more than 1,500 years. Our upper school students often write 60 assignments a year in the classroom, getting detailed feedback and guidance.

GREAT BOOKS: Our upper school students read the complete works (not abridged anthologies) of the great thinkers of the Western tradition: Homer, Augustine, Chaucer, Milton, Melville, etc.

MATH/SCIENCE: PCCA uses an Asian math program called *Right Start* from K through 6th grades, and then *Chicago Math* for the upper school students. All PCCA students finish Biology, Chemistry, Physics, and Algebra 1 and 2, Geometry and Pre-Calculus by their junior year.

HISTORY/FESTIVALS: Each grammar grade integrates all the subjects around the history theme of that year, and end the year with a great festival. For example, 2nd grade students study Ancient Egypt and cap their year with the "King Cluck" science project where they mummify a chicken!

SENIOR THESIS: In their capstone project, students write a lengthy thesis, defend it before the faculty, and formally present it to the school community.
